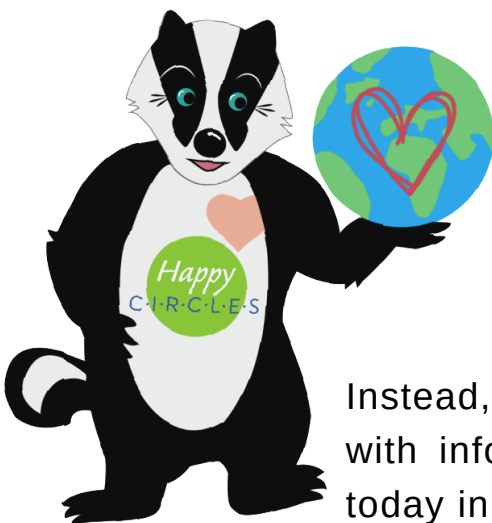


Creating a World that Works for Everyone
